

# Roku Network Connection

The following information will help you connect your Roku TV or Roku streaming device to your In-Home WiFi network.

## Connect to your In-Home WiFi network

1. Turn on your TV. If it's a Roku TV, skip to step 6.
2. Connect your Roku device to your TV using an [HDMI cable](#). If you have a Roku Streaming Stick, plug it into an HDMI port on your TV and skip to step 4.
3. Turn on your Roku device.
4. On your TV, select the input that matches your Roku HDMI connection.
5. Exit your TV settings and go to the Roku Home Screen.
6. Using your Roku remote, select **Settings** > **Network** > **Wireless (Wi-Fi)** > **Set up new Wi-Fi connection**.
7. Select [your WiFi network](#) from the list of available networks.
8. Use the on-screen keyboard to enter [your WiFi network password](#).

## Connect using an Ethernet cable

**Note:** Not all Roku players have an Ethernet port. If your Roku device doesn't have an Ethernet port, follow the instructions above to connect to your In-Home WiFi network.

1. Connect one end of an Ethernet cable to an open port on your router, then connect the other end to your Roku player or Roku TV.
2. Turn on your Roku player or Roku TV. If you have a Roku TV, skip to step 5.
3. Connect your Roku player to your TV using an HDMI cable.
4. On your TV, select the input that matches your Roku device.
5. Select the **Home** button on your remote to go to the Roku Home Screen.
6. Using your Roku remote, select **Settings** > **Network** > **Wired**.
7. Follow the on-screen instructions to finish setting up your internet connection.

## Setting Up Spectrum TV for Roku

### Setting Up Your Roku

To set up Roku for the first time:

1. Visit [Roku.com](#) and create a new account.
2. Follow the prompts to register your Roku player or Roku TV using the code provided.
3. Make sure your Roku is activated and connected to the internet.

### Adding the Spectrum TV Channel to Roku

To add Spectrum TV to your Roku:

1. Make sure your Roku account is activated and your Roku player or TV is connected to the internet.
2. Using your Roku remote, go to the Roku Channel Store.
3. Search for **Spectrum TV** in the Roku Channel Store and install the Spectrum TV channel.
4. Sign in with the virtual keypad, using the **arrow** and **OK** buttons on your Roku remote.
5. Select **I Agree** to accept the License Agreement.

**Note:** You'll be automatically signed in the next time you open Spectrum TV.

To uninstall Spectrum TV from your Roku:

1. Navigate to the Roku Home screen.
2. Click **Options** (the \* symbol) on your remote and then select **Remove Channel**.
3. Select **Remove** to confirm.
